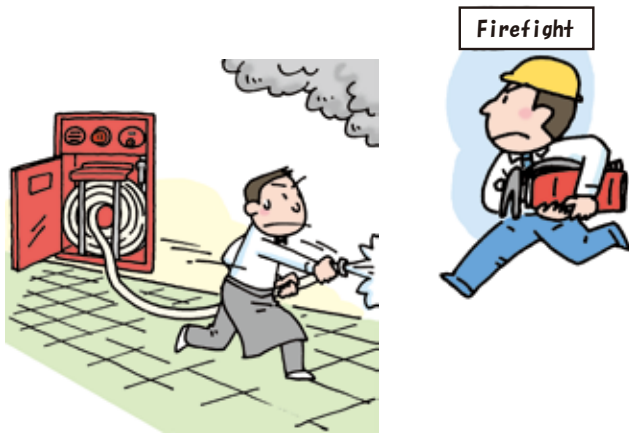







◆ Initial Fire Fighting









- Take a nearby fire extinguisher to the fire scene.
- Use a wall hydrant if the fire is too big for a fire extinguisher.
- Get out immediately if the fire is growing.

How to Use a Fire Extinguisher







- 
- 
- ① Carry it to the fire.    ② Pull off the pin.
- 
- 
- ③ Aim the nozzle at the fire.    ④ Squeeze the handle.
- 
- ⑤ Shoot directly onto the burning object.

How to Use a Wall Hydrant

◇ Wall Hydrant Type 1  
(with hose folded inside)

- 
- ① Select the wall hydrant.
- 
- ② Press the start button.  
(Placed inside or outside.)
- 
- ③ Open the cabinet door.
- 
- ④ Lay out the hose.
- 
- ⑤ Turn on the valve.
- 
- ⑥ Shoot water.

◇ Wall Hydrant Type 2 /  
Easy-To-Handle Wall Hydrant Type 1  
(Hose can be taken easily.  
Nozzle has on-off valve. )

- 
- ① Select the hydrant, and open the door.
- 
- ② Pull out the nozzle.
- 
- ③ Turn on the valve if necessary.
- 
- ④ Lay out the hose.
- 
- ⑤ Open the nozzle.
- 
- ⑥ Shoot water.
